


Yesterday, I found myself in heart of Quiapo.

I'm the type of person who would not normally go to the more chaotic parts of the Metro, prefering to stay in the more orderly areas like the Makati CBD and Bonifacio Global City. And I really do not like unplanned events and spur-of-the-moment decisions. So it was quite a surprise for me that I let myself get tagged along with Joel Aldor and Manolo Noche to the unveiling of the Boix House in Quiapo. ("Boix" is pronounced "bosh"—don't ask me why. It's supposedly a Catalan surname.) It was a decision that I did not regret.

Boix House is a heritage building located along A. Bautista Street surprisingly one block away from Quiapo Church and right beside the Bahay Nakpil-Bautista, which was unfortunately closed that day. 




Colophon: Create your own personal Map tiles (from July 2013)



If you want to make your own map tile out of many (100s or 1000s) of latitude longitude pairs e.g. from Vancouver flickr photos taken 2007-2011 during commuter hours (7-10am., 3-6p.m), here's how:

- Create a file, let's call it "latlong.text" in the format "lat, long" e.g. remove the square brackets from my vancouver 2007-11 flickr commuter file
- · encode it
 - o cat latlong.txt | ./encode -o vancouver2007-2011 -z 16
- · render it
- ./render -A -- vancouver2007-2011/16 49.25706 -123.070538525034 49.29808542 -123.159733 > vancouver-2007-2011.try21.png
- (you will have to play around with the lat and long to make sure they cover the area you want e.g. in the above example I made it so that bounderies were: clark park to the south and east, connaught park to the west and stanley park to the north)

Didal

Among working journalists, we have a term "didal." That is used when a PR (press relations officer) pockets the money intended for a reporter.

So the PR's principal- a government official, a businessman or anybody who is the subject of a news report – thinks that he has paid off the reporter, who doesn't know that his name was used for a media payoff budget.

If a reporter finds out that his name was in the list and he didn't get anything, we tease him, "Na didal ka."

(Accepting money from a source for a story is unethical and is denounced in the practice of journalism. A reporter writes a story because he has discovered something that would be of interest and beneficial to the people and not because someone paid him to do it.

(The reality, however, is that there are PRs whose job should only be to facilitate access to his principal, who payoff media to promote his principal. This is a bad practice.)

We are told that these days the new term for "didal" is "bukol."

We suspect that's what happened to ABS-CBN's Korina Sanchez and GMA 7's Mike Enriquez.



dotPH Wins Online Libel Case

The long ordeal is finally over. In a decision released last October 17, RTC Judge Danilo Buemio dismissed the libel case filed against dotPH by Joel Aquino and Versomina Inc.

It started back in 2008 when a blogger on dotPH's i.ph blogging service wrote several posts warning web designers to stay away from a web design firm called Versomina Inc., also operating under the names Stratvisions, Netpros, Webcomm, Team Creatives, MyTuscany and others. The blogger cited questionable employment practices and oppressive working conditions as reasons for avoiding these companies.

The posts also identified company executives that the blogger claimed were responsible for the questionable practices, including the owner, Mr. Joel Aquino. Comments left on the blog supported these claims, some using profane language. Versomina requested that dotPH take the blog down but dotPH refused, citing the principle of free speech.

"We couldn't take the blog down just because someone said they don't like what it says," said Emil Avancena of dotPH. "We'll only take it down if there's a court order saying it's libelous or otherwise violating the law. So we told Versomina to defend themselves against the accusations online by responding to the comments or putting up their own blog." Joel Aquino responded by filing a libel case against dotPH instead.

Just deleting the blog instead of fighting a court case would have been the easy (and cheaper) alternative, but dotPH didn't back down. "Our CEO, Joel Disini, felt that fighting for the principle was important. Someone should stand up for the man on the street, especially if there was truth to what the blog claimed." said Avancena.

After years of legal fees and showing up for court hearings (several of which were rescheduled because the opposing attorney would not show up), dotPH won when the charges were finally dismissed, "It's a relief that it's over. And finding out that doing the right thing pays off in the end is a great feeling."
