window.onload

- The onload event occurs when all content (e.g. images) also has been loaded.
- \$(window).load(function() {}

\$(document).ready()

- a jQuery function, wrapping and providing consistency to the following events:
 - document.ondomcontentready /
 document.ondomcontentloaded a newish event
 which fires when the document's DOM is loaded
 (which may be some time before the images etc. are
 loaded); again, slightly different in IE and in rest of the
 world
 - and window.onload, which fires when the entire page loads (images, styles, etc.)
